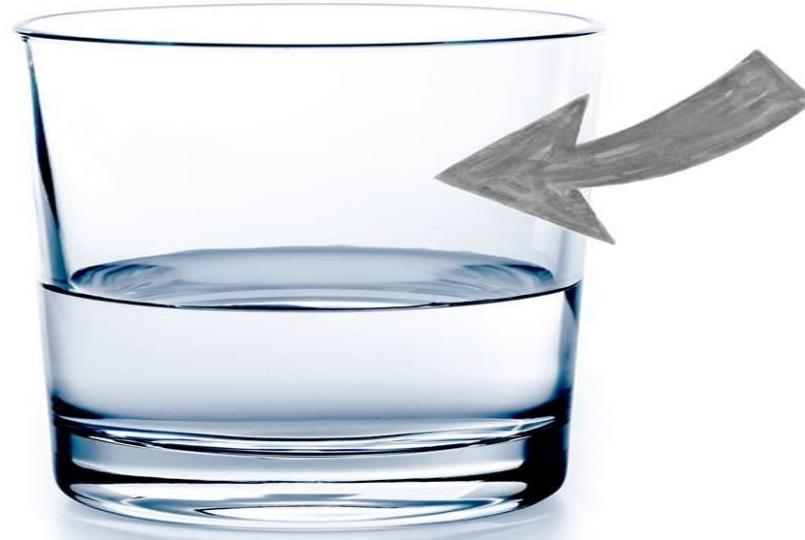


Powerful Proverbial Phrase...
